ANNUAL GENERAL ASSEMBLY, MAY 2009

100% to the Children held its annual general meeting on 2 May 2009 at Vrinner Hoved, Denmark, and around thirty members were in attendance.

The participants at the general meeting agreed that it is still decisive for 100% to the Children to have membership subscriptions and sponsorships be the sole sources of funding for the association's administrative expenses, while contributions and donations are given uncut to the children, i.e. without any deductions, to the four projects in Mombasa, Kenya. This distinction has been our goal from the outset and continues to be in effect.

Throughout the start-up period, the organisation has had its administrative tasks sponsored by having two employees engaged as CSR consultants in a private enterprise, which has thus covered their salary. From 1 January 2009, our employees are employed by 100% to the Children, which has entered into an agreement regarding the first corporate sponsorships.

The general meeting decided to raise the personal 2009 membership subscription to DKK 100, and to introduce a corporate membership of at least DKK 100 per employee in the company, but more will be gladly be accepted if the company so chooses.

The general meeting re-elected the following board members: Mette Ishøy (chairwoman), Torgny Møller (vice chairman) and Morten Kragh-Sørensen, and re-elected Johannes Abildtrup as an alternate member. The FAWCO Foundation's development grant awards presented USD 4,500 to 100% to the Children at the general meeting. This critical health-need donation will meet roughly one-third of the expenses of establishing a health clinic in Kibarani.
